Instructions:

1. Print form below on 8½ by 11 sheet of paper, landscape format
2. Fill out form completely especially phone number (if we have questions) and email address (to send you confirmation when processing is complete), **emergency contact with phone #, sign and date rules section.**
3. **ONE FORM PER PERSON-EVERY PERSON MUST HAVE A SEPARATE FORM FILLED OUT (AGES 3 AND UP).**

All forms must be signed and dated. Parents must sign children's form for all children under the age of 18.

4. If you are joining for less than 4 days -check the appropriate dollar amount box and write the specific days you will be attending. Example: Thurs/Fri/Sat or Fri/Sat/Sun or Sat/Sun, etc.

If you are joining us for all 4 days, just check off the appropriate dollar amount box and circle where you will pick up your registration on Thursday, --- Great Meadows, NJ or Doylestown, PA.

***When picking up your registration on Friday or Saturday or Sunday, it must be picked up at Our Lady of Czestochowa Shrine, 654 Ferry Rd., Doylestown, PA. You CANNOT pick up your registration in the parks. Check below in #7 for the hours our registration team will be at Our Lady of Czestochowa Shrine, Doylestown, PA.**

7. After we receive your request, we will email a confirmation within 1 week. Please print the confirmation page and bring it with you to the pilgrimage.

Sunday- MUST pick up in Doylestown, PA -- 6am - 7:30am

REQUESTS MUST BE RECEIVED IN OUR OFFICE NO LATER THAN JULY 25th—
after that you will need to register at the pilgrimage, **PAYING THE HIGHER AMOUNT.**

REGULAMIN PIESZEJ PIELGRZYMKI

- Pielgrzymka jest podzielona na grupy. Należy przestrzegać przynależności do wyznaczonej grupy.
 - Młodzież poniżej osiemnastu lat powinna przedstawić pisemną zgodę rodziców lub opiekunów na udział w pielgrzymce.
 - Dzieci pozostają pod całkowitą opieką rodziców lub opiekunów przez cały czas trwania pielgrzymki.
 - Na pielgrzymce zabronione są noclegi koedukacyjne (nie dotyczy rodzin).
 - W miejscach noclegowych obowiązuje cisza nocna, która rozpoczyna się pół godziny po wieczornym nabożeństwie i trwa do porannej pobudki.
 - Ewentualne problemy zdrowotne należy zgłosić przy rejestracji.
 - Pielgrzym powinien być wyposażony w leki pierwszej potrzeby oraz podstawowe środki opatrunkowe.
 - Podczas pielgrzymki bezwzględnie zabrania się palenia papierosów, picia napojów alkoholowych i używania narkotyków.
 - Uczestników pielgrzymki obowiązuje właściwy ubiór stosowny do religijnego charakteru pielgrzymki.
 - Pielgrzymce mogą towarzyszyć tylko samochody obsługi.
 - Rozbijanie i zwijanie namiotów indywidualnych każdy pielgrzym dokonuje we własnym zakresie.
 - Miejsca postojów, noclegów i trasę przemarszu pielgrzymi pozostawiają w czystości i porządku.
 - Filmowanie pielgrzymki możliwe jest tylko za zgodą organizatorów.
 - Pielgrzymów obowiązuje całkowite podporządkowanie się służbom pielgrzymkowym, respektowanie ich zaleceń oraz powyższego regulaminu.
 - Pielgrzymi, którzy nie będą przestrzegać zasad ustanowionych w regulaminie, będą musieli opuścić pielgrzymkę.
 - Każdy pielgrzym zobowiązany jest do zachowania wszelkich środków bezpieczeństwa, zarówno na trasie jak i w miejscach odpoczynku oraz noclegów.
 - Wszystkie symbole religijne, sztandary, specjalne stroje, plakaty itd. muszą być zaaprobowane przez organizatora pielgrzymki.
 - Zabrania się reklamy, rozdawania ulotek (z religijnymi włącznie) itd. bez zgody organizatora pielgrzymki.
 - Organizatorzy zastrzegają sobie prawo zmian podejmowania decyzji w sytuacjach nie przewidzianych niniejszym Regulaminem.
 - Wzięcie udziału w Pielgrzymce równoważne jest ze zwolnieniem Parafii św. św. Piotra i Pawła, proboszcza oraz pracowników Parafii, pracowników Pielgrzymki, Diecezji Metuchen oraz Biskupa Diecezji Metuchen z wszelkiej odpowiedzialności za jakiegokolwiek straty, uszkodzenia czy obrażenia.**
- THE PILGRIMAGE RULES**
- The Cross shall lead the pilgrimage at all times, followed by the Marian emblems, and then the pilgrims.
 - The pilgrimage will be divided into groups. All participants should stay with their assigned group.
 - All children should stay under the care of their parent(s) or guardian. Children under 18, traveling without a parent, must have an appointed guardian who is on the pilgrimage. Parents then must fill out a Guardian Form when registering their child.
 - At each campsite, all pilgrims shall observe the night silence which begins 30 minutes after the evening Mass concludes and remains in effect until morning.
 - Pilgrims with health problems are expected to notify pilgrimage organizers at the time of registration.
 - Smoking and using alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs are prohibited during the entire course of the pilgrimage.**
 - Religious character of the Pilgrimage requires appropriate attire. No beach or similar attire is permitted.
 - Only service cars can accompany the pilgrims. Because of safety concerns no other cars will be allowed to follow the pilgrimage. **No cars are allowed to stop by the pilgrims.**
 - Every Pilgrim needs to supply their own camping equipment and tent and are responsible for setting it up in the evening and taking it down the following morning. The pilgrimage service personnel will not be responsible for pitching private tents or packing them up. (Please label **ALL** your equipment)
 - Littering is prohibited in rest areas, nightly campsites, and along the entire route of the pilgrimage.
 - There is no fee for videotaping or filming this event but, upon registering, a film waiver form must be filled out and signed. Notify the person registering you that you will be filming.
 - All pilgrims are expected to follow the directions of the pilgrimage service personnel at all times.
 - Pilgrims who do not follow the pilgrimage rules will be dismissed from the pilgrimage immediately.
 - All pilgrims are expected to follow safety rules on the road as well as at the campsites.
 - All religious symbols, banners, uniforms, posters, etc., must be approved by the head of the Pilgrimage.
 - There shall be no soliciting of any kind without the consent of the head of the Walking Pilgrimage.
 - In all cases that are not covered by the pilgrimage rules, the pilgrimage organizers will make the final decision as needed.
